### Rearranged matches:

Please note that **both** teams must report details in writing to the Fixtures Secretary of any match not played by the scheduled date, and that no team is obliged to accept a postponement except when circumstances outside the control of the teams make the fulfilment of the fixture impossible or when a player is required for a Buckinghamshire or Slough representative match on the same date.

### Completion time for fixtures:

Two weeks are allowed for the completion of re-arranged fixtures after the scheduled finish:  
i.e.  
all fixtures must be completed by Friday 9 April;

Following a resolution at the 1997 Annual General Meeting, matches not played will be declared void.

## Start times:

All matches must start by 7.30 p.m. [Rule 12(h)].

# MASTERS TOURNAMENT

## REGULATIONS:

1. Entry is by invitation only in accordance with the following qualifications:
2. (a) Every invitee must have played in more than half of his team's scheduled League matches;  
(b) Winner of the Men's Singles title at the Slough Closed Championships;  
(c) Top five averages in the League;  
(d) Last two places plus reserves in order of sets won in the League;  
(e) In the event of a tie, preference will be given to the player who has appeared in the greatest number of League matches;  
(f) All the above to apply to the current season only.
3. The tournament will be played on a straight knock-out basis, best of five games.
4. Each round will be drawn independently immediately before the commencement of the round and there shall be no seeding.

# **SLOUGH & DISTRICT TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE RULES**

## **CONSTITUTION AND ADMINISTRATION**

( as at 1st June 2008 )

### **GENERAL**

1. This association of clubs shall be known as the Slough and District Table Tennis League.
2. Membership of the League shall constitute affiliation to the English Table Tennis Association and to the Buckinghamshire County Table Tennis Association.
3. (a) All matches and competitions promoted by the League shall be conducted under the current rules of the English Table Tennis Association.  
(b) White coloured outer clothing, except shoes and socks, shall not be worn by players in any event promoted by the League.

### **MANAGEMENT**

4. **MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**
  - (a) The Management Committee of the League shall comprise of the offices of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, General Secretary, Treasurer, Fixtures Secretary, Inter-League Secretary, Competitions Secretary, Slough Closed Championships Organiser and Press Secretary, plus any number of additional members.
  - (b) The Management Committee shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting, but is subject to alterations proposed by a Special General Meeting.
  - (c) The Management Committee is empowered to co-opt persons to fill casual vacancies and to form sub-committees as necessary.
  - (d) The Management Committee shall meet monthly.
  - (e) A quorum of four members, two of which shall be officers, shall be necessary for the execution of business and each member present shall be entitled to one vote. In the event of an equality of votes for and against any motion, a casting vote is exercisable by the Chairman of the Meeting.

### **FINANCE**

5. (a) All monies belonging to the League shall be paid into an account approved by the Management Committee in the name of the Slough and District Table Tennis League.  
(b) The signatures of any two of the Chairman, General Secretary and the Treasurer shall be required for any withdrawal.  
(c) Clubs in default of payment of monies due to the League may be liable to a 10% non-cumulative surcharge for each calendar month or part month for which monies are outstanding. Further, if such monies remain outstanding by 1st January, then the defaulting club may be expelled for the season and their record may be deleted.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

6. **AFFILIATION OF CLUBS**
  - (a) An affiliation form will be sent to all affiliated clubs and any other clubs who may apply by the 30th June.
  - (b) These forms, duly completed, will be returned to the General Secretary by 31<sup>st</sup> July.
  - (c) A club shall enter its teams on the affiliation form in order of strength.
  - (d) Should a club's details, as shown in the handbook, not be correct, then it is the responsibility of the club to notify the General Secretary and all clubs concerned of the changes.
7. **AFFILIATION FEES**
  - (a) Clubs shall pay the following fees to the League each season:
    - (i) In respect of each team playing in the senior divisions - £40.00.
    - (ii) In respect of each team playing in the youth division - £35.00.
  - (b) Such fees shall be paid not later than 15th October.
8. **DEPOSITS**
  - (a) Each club shall deposit with the League the sum of £5.00, plus £1.00 per team for each additional team after the first.
  - (b) Fines and other monies due to the League may be taken from such deposits at the discretion of the Management Committee.
  - (c) Such deposits shall, in the case of a new club, be paid or, in the case of a club having played the previous season, be made up to the required amount by the 31<sup>st</sup> July.
  - (d) The deposit in respect of a team shall be returned when the team is either removed by the

Committee or resigns from the League, subject to its having fulfilled all its commitments within the League to the satisfaction of the Committee.

- (e) In the case of a club having more than one team, forfeiture of the initial £5.00 deposit will be applied first when one of the teams fails to fulfil its commitments within the League.

#### 9. APPROVAL OF FACILITIES

- (a) The venue and location of a member club shall be subject to the approval of the Management Committee.
- (b) It is a condition of entry into the League that the suitability of its venue for table tennis matches remains the responsibility of each club, who undertake to indemnify the League and League officers from any liability, howsoever caused.

#### 10. REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- (a) Registration of players shall be effected by completing the appropriate form and sending it, if between the 1st June and 31st August to the General Secretary; registrations outside this period should be sent direct to the Fixtures Secretary.
- (b) Unless authorised by the Management Committee, no registration shall be accepted after 31st January in each season.
- (c) A fee of £3.00 is payable by each registered player. Players registered with the General Secretary shall remit to the Treasurer by 15th October. Those registered with the Fixtures Secretary must include the remittance with the registration form, otherwise the registration is invalid.
- (d) Every club shall register at least four players for the lowest or only team in the senior divisions and at least three players for each other team.
- (e) A club with more than one team when registering a player, shall indicate for which team he is to be registered and no player may play for a team lower than that for which he is registered.
- (f) Players may be registered for the same club for teams in both the senior divisions and the youth division provided that registration fees have been paid in respect of both.
- (g) Players may be registered for one club in the senior divisions and a different club in the youth division provided that registration fees have been paid in respect of both.
- (h) No player may be registered for more than one club at the same time except as provided under the provisions of rule 10(g).
- (i) No player may play in any match until 24 hours after he has been registered.
- (j) A player wishing to be re-registered for or transferred to another team, shall apply to the Management Committee.
- (k) There will be a fine of £6.00 on a team playing an unregistered player.

### LEAGUE COMPETITION

#### 11. FORMATION OF DIVISIONS

- (a) The formation of divisions shall be decided by the Management Committee.
- (b) All rules governing the youth division may be modified in order to meet the requirements of the E.T.T.A. Woolwich Junior Leagues or equivalent.

#### 12. MATCHES

- (a) Each team shall play matches at home and away as scheduled in the official list of fixtures and as decided by the Management Committee against every other team in its division, except that the youth division may be organised on a session format at a central venue where rules 12(g), (h), (i) and (j) shall not apply.
- (b) In the senior divisions a match shall consist of ten sets (each set being the best of five games), each of three players in one team playing singles against each of three players in the other team and two players from each team playing one set of doubles.
- (c) Unless mutually agreed otherwise by the captains, the order of play shall be as follows: 1. AvX 2. BvY 3. CvZ 4. BvX 5. AvZ 6. CvY 7. Doubles 8. BvZ 9. CvX 10. AvY. The home team shall enter its players' names first.
- (d) In the youth division a match shall consist of five sets (each set being the best of five games), each of two players in one team playing singles against each of two players in the other team and two players from each team playing one set of doubles.
- (e) Unless mutually agreed otherwise by the captains, the order of play shall be as follows: 1. AvY 2. BvZ 3. AvZ 4. BvY 5. Doubles. The home team shall enter its players' names first.
- (f) Reserve players may be introduced into the doubles set in all divisions.
- (g) Each match shall start by 7.30 p.m. and be played to a finish.
- (h) A team not represented at 7.30 p.m. shall forfeit set no. 1.
- (i) A team not represented at 7.45 p.m. shall forfeit sets nos. 1 and 2.
- (j) A team not represented at 8.00 p.m. shall forfeit the whole match.
- (k) When the youth division is run on a session format, a team not represented at the appointed commencing time for a match shall forfeit set no. 1. A team not represented 15 minutes later shall forfeit set no. 2 and a team not represented 30 minutes later shall forfeit the whole match.
- (l) A player not present when needed to play in accordance with the order of play in rule 12(c) and (e) shall forfeit that set.
- (m) If both players required for a set are absent, that set shall be null and void.

- (n) The home team shall forward an official score card completed and signed by both captains within three days of the match.
- (o) A team may be fined £3.00 for each player they are short in any match.

### 13. REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- (a) A player on playing his fourth match for a team or teams higher than that for which he is registered, shall be re-registered for the lowest of such higher teams.
- (b) A player may not play for more than one team from the same club in the same division except as allowed under rule 10(h).
- (c) Players registered in the youth division may also play for the same club in the senior divisions up to a total of three times, and any number of times after becoming additionally registered for a team in the senior divisions in accordance with rule 10(f). Players registered for a different club in the senior divisions may not play in the senior divisions for the club for which they are registered in the youth division.

### 14. DETERMINATION OF LEAGUE POSITIONS

- (a) In senior division matches a team will be awarded a point for each set won.
- (b) In youth division matches a team will be awarded a point for each set won.
- (c) Teams will be listed in the order of points being awarded to them.
- (d) The positions of teams having gained an equal number of points shall be decided firstly by the number of sets won and if still equal, by the difference of games won to games lost.

### 15. PROMOTION AND RELEGATION

- (a) At the end of the season the highest placed team in each division below the highest division shall be promoted to the next highest division and the lowest placed team in each division above the lowest division shall be relegated to the next lowest division.
- (b) At the end of the season the second highest placed team in each division below the highest division shall play a match, at a venue and on a date to be decided by the Management Committee, against the second lowest placed team in the next highest division. In the event of both teams winning five sets the winner shall be determined by the difference between games won and games lost and if still equal by the difference between points won to points lost and if still equal by the result of the doubles set. The winning team of this match shall be placed in the higher division for the following season and the losing team shall be placed in the lower division.

### 16. POSTPONED AND UNPLAYED MATCHES

- (a) Matches may be played at any time prior to the scheduled date.
- (b) In the event of a fixture not being played by the scheduled date, both teams shall report details to the Fixtures Secretary in writing within seven days.
- (c) Within 28 days of the original date both teams must inform the Fixtures Secretary of the re-arranged date of any match which the Fixtures Secretary allows to be played.
- (d) Inability of regular players to take part in any League match shall not be deemed sufficient reason for the match not being played.
- (e) Exemption from rule 16(d) may be claimed when a member of a team is required for a Bucks County or Slough League representative commitment on the same night by notifying the Fixtures Secretary and the opposing team not less than five days prior to the scheduled date of the match.
- (f) No re-arranged match shall be played later than two weeks after the last full week as shown in the fixtures list.
- (g) Any team which fails to fulfil a fixture and subsequently concedes the match may be fined £9.00 in the Senior Divisions and £6.00 in the Youth Divisions.

## A. DILGER CUP

### 17. ADMINISTRATION

- (a) Each season the League run a knock-out handicap competition for the A. Dilger Cup.
- (b) Every team in the senior divisions shall be eligible to enter.
- (c) No player may represent more than one team during the season except as provided by rule 10(h).
- (d) One player per team per season may be promoted from a team from the same club but in one of the lower senior divisions, provided that he has not played for his or any other team.
- (e) The entry fee shall be £3.00 per team due by 15th October.
- (f) The final shall be played at a venue to be decided by the Competitions Secretary.

### 18. HANDICAPS

- (a) To be eligible for a handicap a player must have played in a total of four matches in the senior divisions during the previous season and the present season up to 30th November. Players not having played four matches by 30th November and those registered after this date may apply for a handicap after having played four matches. Appearances in doubles sets only do not count.
- (b) Each eligible player will be allocated into a handicap group and the handicap group for a team will be the average (to the nearest whole number) of the handicaps of the three players taking part in the match.
- (c) A handicap to be assessed from a chart by comparing the team handicap groups shall be

awarded to the team playing from the higher group.

#### 19. MATCHES

- (a) It is the responsibility of the team drawn at home to notify its opposition of the arrangements for the match.
- (b) Matches will be of ten sets in the same format as for League matches, but each set will consist of four games only scored up to 11.
- (c) Reserve players may not take part in the doubles set.
- (d) All the points scored in the match will be totalled, the handicap applied and the team scoring the most points will be deemed the winner.
- (e) In the event of a tie, the match must be replayed with the team drawn away having choice of venue.
- (f) Rules 12(h), (i), (j), (l), (m) and (n) shall also apply to the A. Dilger Cup competition.
- (g) If a match remains unplayed by the end of the scheduled period, the outcome will be decided by the Competitions Secretary.

### TUNES CUP

#### 20. ADMINISTRATION

- (a) Every team in the Youth Division shall be eligible to enter a knockout handicap competition for the Tunes Cup.
- (b) No player may represent more than one team during the season except as provided by Rule 10(h).
- (c) One player per team per season may be promoted from a team from the same club but in a lower division, provided that this player has not played for his own or any other team.

#### 21. HANDICAP

- (a) To be eligible a player must have played in a total of three league matches during the present season up to 31st December. After 31st December, players not having played three matches and those registered after this date may apply for a handicap after having played three matches. Appearances in the doubles sets only do not count.
- (b) Each eligible player will be allocated into a handicap group and the handicap group for a team will be the average of the handicaps of the two players taking part in the match, rounding down to the nearest whole number.
- (c) A handicap to be assessed from a chart by comparing the team handicap shall be awarded to the team playing from the higher group.

#### 22. MATCHES

- (a) Matches will be of five sets in the same format as Youth Division matches, but each set will consist of four games only scored up to 11 points.
- (b) Reserve players may not take part in the doubles set.
- (c) All the points scored in the match will be totalled, the handicap applied and the team scoring the most points will be deemed the winner.
- (d) Rules 12(k), 12(l), 12(m) shall also apply to the Tunes Cup.
- (e) In the event of a tie, the match will be decided by doubles. The handicap applied will be divided by five and the team winning on handicap will be deemed the winners. If this still results in a tie the result will be decided by the toss of a coin.

### SUMMER LEAGUE

#### 24. ADMINISTRATION

- (a) Each year the League may run a Summer League between the months of May and August inclusive.
- (b) All clubs who participated in the Summer League the previous year and any others who have shown interest in competing, shall be sent entry forms by the end of April.
- (c) The entry fee shall be £6-00 per team plus £2-00 for each registered player and must be included with the entry form.

#### 25. MATCHES

- (a) Matches will consist of four singles sets (two players of one team each playing two players of the other team) plus one doubles set in which teams may introduce reserve players. All sets will be decided by the best of three games.
- (b) Unless mutually agreed otherwise by the captains the order of play shall be as follows: 1. AvY 2. BvZ 3. AvZ 4. BvY 5. Doubles. The home team shall enter its players' names first.
- (c) Rules 12(h), (i), (j), (l), (m), (n), (o) and 16 shall also apply to the Summer League.

#### 26. REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- (a) Players may be registered at any time during the season but those registering after the closing date for entries shall be accepted at the discretion of the Management Committee. Every club

shall register at least three players for the lowest or only team and at least two players for each other team. Rules 10(e) and 13(b) shall apply to the Summer League.

- (b) A player on playing his third match for a team or teams higher than that for which he is registered, shall be re-registered for the lowest of such higher teams.

#### 27. DETERMINATION OF LEAGUE POSITIONS

- (a) One point shall be awarded for every set won.
- (b) Teams will be listed in the order of points awarded to them.
- (c) The positions of teams having an equal number of points shall be determined by the team having won the greater number of matches; if still equal, games won to games lost will decide.

#### INTER-LEAGUE REPRESENTATION

- 28. (a) The number of teams competing in any inter-league competition shall be decided by the Management Committee.
- (b) The organization of inter-league teams is the responsibility of the Inter-League Secretary.
- (c) The teams and team captains shall be appointed by the Selection Sub-Committee.

#### CLOSED CHAMPIONSHIPS

##### 29. COMPOSITION

The Management Committee shall decide which events will comprise the League Closed Championships.

##### 30. ELIGIBILITY

- (a) To be eligible for the championships a registered player must fulfil one of the following conditions:
  - (i) Have played in four matches in the League and/or Dilger Cup/Tunes Cup in the present season up to 31st December.
  - (ii) Be registered only in the Slough and District League.
  - (iii) Hold Life Membership of the League.
- (b) In exceptional circumstances the Management Committee may over-rule the above conditions.
- (c) To qualify for the divisional singles a player must have played two matches in the division for which he or she is registered at the date of entry for the Championships.
- (d) Additional regulations regarding eligibility may be specified by the Management Committee.

#### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- 31. (a) The Annual General Meeting shall be held not later than the last week in May each year.
- (b) To call the Annual General Meeting the General Secretary shall give at least ten days notice to each club.
- (c) Members with nominations for the Management Committee or any other resolutions they require to be placed on the agenda shall submit these, in writing, to the General Secretary not later than 30th April.
- (d) The meeting shall transact the following:
  - (i) Minutes of the previous A.G.M. shall be confirmed and any matters arising therefrom dealt with.
  - (ii) Presentation of the Annual Report and Financial Report.
  - (iii) Alterations to rules.
  - (iv) Election of Officers and Management Committee members.
  - (v) Election of Auditor(s).
  - (vi) Election of President, Vice-Presidents and any other special categories. Nominations for Vice-Presidents, Life Members and additions to the Roll of Honour may be proposed only by the Management Committee.
  - (vii) Any other business.
- (e) Amendments to any proposals or resolutions on the agenda, if they relate to the same subject matter, will be accepted from the floor of the meeting.
- (f) Every Vice-President, Officer, Management Committee Member, Life Member and registered player shall be entitled to vote except that the Chairman or acting Chairman shall have a casting vote only.
- (g) No one member shall represent more than one club at a General Meeting. A fine of £5.00 shall be imposed on any club not so represented.

#### SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

- 32. (a) A Special General Meeting shall be called by the General Secretary within three weeks and giving at least ten days notice if so directed by the Management Committee or on receipt of a written request by at least 20% of the member clubs, stating the reason.
- (b) Voting rights are to be as in Rule 31(f).

## ADMINISTRATION

### 33. ALTERATIONS TO RULES

- (a) A copy of these rules is to be supplied to each member.
- (b) No rule shall be altered, added to or rescinded nor introduced except at the Annual General Meeting or a Special General Meeting.
- (c) Members with proposals for alterations to rules to be placed on the A.G.M. agenda shall submit them in writing to reach the General Secretary not later than 20th March.
- (d) Not later than 21st April the General Secretary shall circulate to all clubs the proposals received under Rule 33(c) together with alterations to rules proposed by the Management Committee.

## GENERAL

- 34. (a) A handbook shall be supplied free of charge to every registered player.
- (b) The trophies owned by the League shall be the responsibility of the holders and shall be surrendered to the League each year by the date specified in the League Handbook and decided by the Management Committee. Any club not returning these trophies by these dates may be fined £5.00.
- (c) In the event of any question or matter arising which has not been provided for by the foregoing, such matters will be dealt with by the Management Committee whose decision shall be final and binding.

## RETURN OF TROPHIES

Please note Rule 34(b) regarding return of trophies belonging to the League. The dates for the return of these trophies have been set as follows:

## AWARD OF TROPHIES

Please note that trophies will be awarded by the League in team competitions in line with the following policy:

League Divisions:	all team members who have played in at least one-third of the matches played by the team;
Knock-Out Competitions:	any player who has appeared in the competition.

The League will not provide trophies except to players who have qualified as above.
